Enrolling in Victorian Government Schools in Boroondara

Information for parents



Enrolment Process for Boroondara State Primary Schools

Primary schools in the Boroondara schools network recommend that you consider the advice below when enrolling your child in a local school. This will ensure that your chosen school can best plan for your child, and all children enrolled, at the school.

We care for your child's education and view the enrolment process as a partnership between you the parent, your child's pre-school and the primary school. Our aim is to make the transition from pre-school to primary school a rewarding and satisfying process.

The Enrolment Process:

- 1** To be enrolled in a state primary school in 2010 a **child must turn five years of age on or before 30 April 2010**. Speak to your pre-school teacher if you have any concerns about your child's readiness for school.
- 2** Information from your local primary schools will be available in your pre-school setting early in Term Two.
- 3** To assist you in finding a local school that best suits your child's needs, talk to parents whose child/children attend the school. Gain information by talking to a range of parents, not just a single opinion.
- 4** Contact the school to arrange for a tour of the school. Some schools have a set time for tours when you can 'just turn up'. Please check each school's documentation for individual school arrangements.
- 5** Arrange your visit during school hours to see the students in their learning environment.

6 You are welcome to visit any of the schools in your neighbourhood to find one that suits your child however please visit your local school first. A number of our schools have a limit on their intake and only take students from their immediate area. Other schools have specific zones. See www.emr.vic.edu.au.

7 Most primary schools offer **Transition Programs** during the year so that pre-school children become familiar with the school setting prior to the start of the Prep year. Schools encourage your participation in these programs so take advantage of them.

8 Parents are advised that enrolments in Boroondara primary schools are due by **31 August**. Enrolment Forms are available from your local school. If you consider that your child may be eligible for disabilities funding it is important to mention this to the Principal at the time of enrolling and certainly prior to June.

9 Prior to commencing school you must produce documentary evidence of **Date of Birth and a completed Immunisation Certificate**. In some cases both of these may not be available until nearer the time of commencing school. Don't put off enrolling after August if you are still waiting for completion of an Immunisation Certificate – this can be handed to the school later in the year. Enrolment is not complete without proof of age.

10 Schools require a passport and visa for children born overseas.

For your convenience you will find overleaf a list of state primary schools in Boroondara with the name of the school Principal and the school telephone number.

Transition from pre-school to primary school is an exciting and special time. We hope you enjoy the process and look forward to assisting you in this venture.
