BIKE ED PROGRAM Expression of Interest

Dear Parents,

During Term 3, Grade 5/6 students have the opportunity to participate in the Bike Ed program at school. This program will run on a Thursday morning during Grade 5/6 Sport time (9am-10.40am) beginning **August 24**, for three weeks.

For this program your child will be required to bring their bike to school each week. The program covers bike maintenance, maintaining control of your bike in different situations and road rules.

The program consists of classroom and cycling activities completed on school grounds, on-road and footways.

It is also a requirement for this program that every child's bike and helmet receive a maintenance check from a bike shop. Ashburton Cycles in the Ashburton set of shops will do these checks for free, although there may be a cost involved if they need to repair the bike to a satisfactory standard. Depending on the cycle shop workload, you may need to allow one week for repairs.

Please complete the form below to indicate your child's intent to be a part of the program by **Tuesday 15th August 2017**. Due to the nature of the program, only a limited number of places are available, and students who ride regularly will have priority.
