Chicken Hatching Program



Dear Grade Two Parents,

As part of our investigation into the topic ‘Life Cycles – Watch It Grow’ this term, we will be having a chicken hatching program in our classrooms between Monday 7<sup>th</sup> May and Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May.

During this time, the children will investigate the life cycle of a chicken. An incubator and brooder box will be left in each classroom to enable the children to experience and record the development of the newly hatched chicks. We can’t wait to meet our fluffy friends and watch them grow!

If your family is interested in taking care of the chickens over the weekend of the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> of May, please contact your child’s class teacher. If you are interested, your class teacher will be able to pass on information from the Living Eggs team.
