The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and Glen Iris Primary School is excited to be participating.

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by **Friday 26th August 2016**. This will allow me 2 weeks to verify books and data entered.

Students from Prep - 2 are required to read 30 books (20 or more must be from the 'Challenge List'- see website). You may read by yourself or with an adult or friend.

Students from 3-6 are required to read 15 books (10 or more must be from the 'Challenge List'- see website).

Change in Rules

The rules this year have changed slightly. **All students** are now encouraged to participate and have been registered with a personal username and password. These are being handed out today. They will all receive a certificate for completing the challenge. If you would like their name to appear on the Honour Roll, please complete the form that was sent home in Term 2.
