To complement our study of the Solar System, the Grade 5/6 students will be participating in a Starlab incursion run by experienced presenters from the Science Discovery Dome.

Starlab is an inflatable igloo-like dome equipped with projection cylinders that demonstrate the night sky, star constellations and close up views of the planets. Each class will be involved in a 45-minute session with a Science Discovery presenter on <u>Wednesday 1st March</u>. The topics that will be covered include:

- The Solar System when, how and what's in it
- Discovery of other stars with planetary systems
- Names and characteristics of the planets
- Sizes and distances in space
- Scientific discoveries by probes and satellites
